

GRADUATION PROGRAM IN LEGAL SCIENCE

The Graduation Program in Legal Sciences (Master and Doctorate) of UENP carries out oriented research on Theories of Justice: Justice and Exclusion and has two research lines: State and Responsibility - Critical Issues and Political Function of the Law. Having as a main focus the interdisciplinary study of the Social Exclusion, the Program seeks to stimulate the critical capacity to perceive the failures and distortions of the mechanisms of Justice activation and their corresponding formal devices, in order to conceive and introduce for cutouts, loopholes in dogmatic rigidity, sustained in the supremacy of the human dignity principle.

The historical mission of the Graduation is linked to the regional context. The themes linked to the research about Theories of Justice: Justice and Exclusion enable the development of projects that can collaborate for both deeper understanding and the integrated regional damages, besides contributing to the articulation of actions able to interfere positively in their social dynamics. The studies, still, are not linked only to the elaboration of regional micro analysis absolutely transcending the mesoregional interest.

DOUBLE DEGREE

The Doctorate Program in Legal Science of UENP has a Joint Degree agreement with the University of Murcia, Spain. The special system guarantees the student from both Universities, when participating in an academic exchange for a minimum of nine months, the doctorate degree with validity in Brazil and throughout the European Union.

RESEARCH LINES

I. State and Responsibility: Critical Issues

This research line promotes the historical research of the Theories of the State, giving priority to the defense of the democratic system as a fundamental rule of the preservation of the human person values, structured in the State-Society relationship, away from the strict legalism must provide the adequacy of law to social contexts to which it is intended. Within this line, some issues can be studied such as responsibility of the State, crisis of State Responsibility, effectiveness of Human Rights, minimum State and the Welfare State, among others

II. Political Function of the Law

Considering that law and politics are not in opposition, this research line emerges from the concern about the hierarchical chain of Human Rights, from which leads to linking with topics such as Democracy and Distributive Justice, Human Rights and Democracy; Social Dimension of Law, Criminology, among others. This research line is also structured from three fundamental axes: a) Criminology; b) Democracy; c) Education and Civil Society.

Nowadays, there are 63 projects and 7 extension programs developed at UENP campuses. Many of the extension programs occur in partnership with the State and Federal governments: University Extension Program (PROEXT); University Without Borders (USF) and its sub-programs as Parana Good Business (PBNP), Municipal Office of Jacarezinho and Center for the Study and Defense of Children and Youth's rights (NEDDIJ); Rondon Project; Institutional Program of Initial Extension Scholarship (PIBEX); Program of Tutorial Education (PET); Program for Education Development (PDE); besides special programs as Language and Literature in Action; Nucleus for Agroecology and Territories (NEAT); Continued Education for Guardianship Councilors.

Jacarezinho is a city located in the Northern Pioneer of Paraná, 385 km far from Curitiba, the State capital, with an estimated population of 40 thousand inhabitants. The city, which houses Jacarezinho Campus and the University Rector's Office, is recognized by the cultural, religious and educational thrust.
